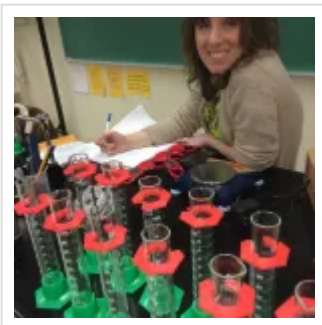

We have grown! Two years ago this tournament was completely contained within Howell Hall and the adjoining lab building. This year we utilized space in 5 building on campus!

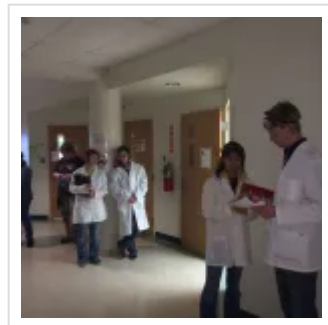
Next year's tournament is already on the UCO calendar – March 7th, 2015.

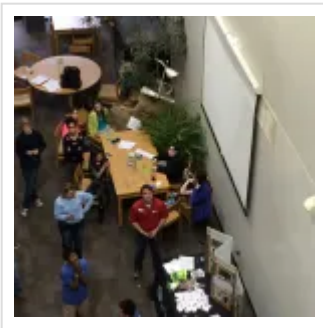

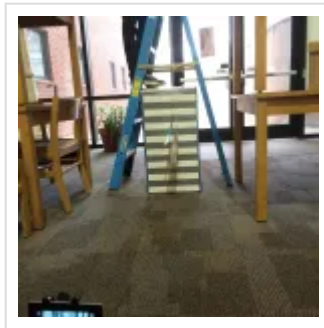

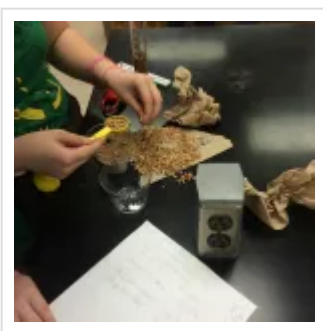
Helicopter testing in the Atrium



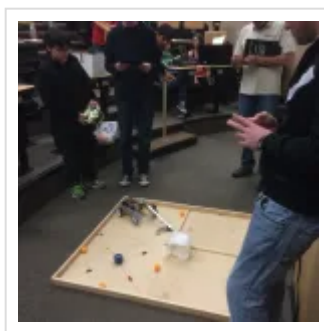
Bungee drop test. Note the iPad recording using a slow motion stop action app.

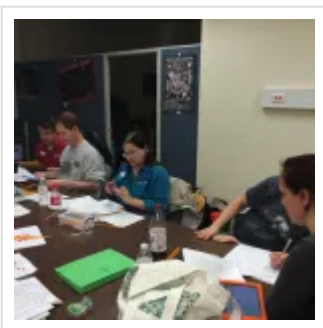
